Due diligence will be carried out on those suppliers where there are identified risks of modern slavery.

We will mitigate identified risks of slavery and human trafficking in our supply chains.

A Modern Slavery course has been added to our Learning Management System library and is part of the annual compliance training programme rolled out to employees.
